THE VISION

We want to start a UofN campus in Nigeria. Since April 2010 we have been following a training period at the "mothercampus" of the UofN Kona. At the end of 2012 we would like to give an update on the past year and our plans for 2013.

LOOKING BACK ON 2012

Jackson's studies progressed rapidly as he completed one course after the other.



In January he designed an **Ecoponics** system which he implemented in the YWAM Campus in Port Harcourt Nigeria during our trip in April. In July his studies continued with **African Garden Expressions**, comparing five different organic farms and carefully assessing the benefits of each. During the September quarter he followed the **Introduction to Primary Health Care** Training, a medical school in which he learnt how to respond in remote areas when there are no doctors, nurses or hospitals around. The school combined theory with practical skills such as making a cast, using a stethoscope and doing baby checks.

At the beginning of the year Anneke and Hope Shekinah continued going to the office in the mornings as Darlene's Kona Assistant. After the April trip she also started assisting Loren Cunningham as well. It has been a

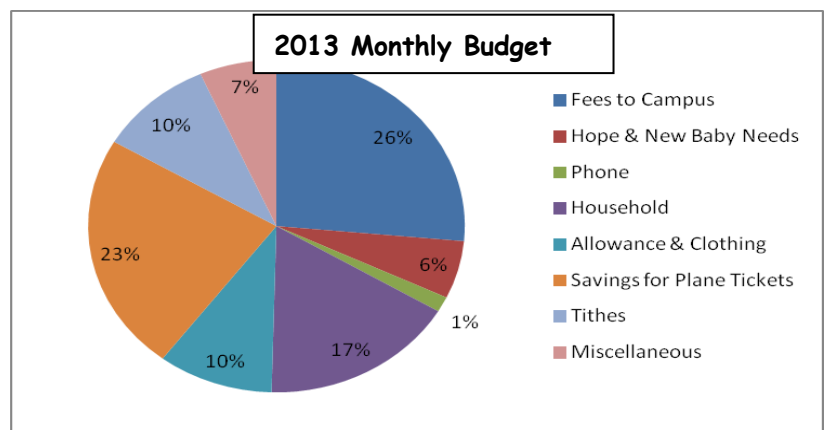
